### Presentation

The European Yeti Award contest is organized as part of [European Yeti project](#) which is funded through ERASMUS+ programme. The project's aim is to support young people in their commitment to share and value Europe in a more sustainable way by developing their skills and knowledge in the field of eco-tourism.

This contest is organized to highlight European best practices in the field of eco-tourism and the Award will be given to the initiatives that has inspired the most the jury.

The participation is free of charge.

### Who can participate?

Young people living in Europe, aged 20-35 years old, that have developed their eco-tourism project or initiative in Europe.

### The Award

One winner of the European Yeti Award will be awarded with 1000 euros for their initiative in the eco-tourism field and will be able to attend one of The European Yeti training programs organized in Romania or France, in 2022, with all expenses paid – travel, accommodation and meals.

Additionally, 2 other finalists will be able to attend one of The European Yeti training programs organized in Romania or France, in 2022, with all expenses paid – travel, accommodation and meals.

### The jury

The jury consists of 15 persons, 3 people from each partner country involved in the European Yeti project – France, Malta, Romania, Sweden, Ireland – on the long run.

### Evaluation

The Award will be chosen through a grid of criteria that has been defined by the partners, experts in the field of eco-tourism and youth initiatives.

The criteria are:

1. Originality
2. Appealing and enjoyable
3. Innovation for society

4. Capacity of transmission /shareability

5. Feasibility

The jury will grade each criterion and discuss their choices during a session moderated by an expert. This session will take place on the **9th of March 2022**, in Galway, Ireland.
